Children's Ministry



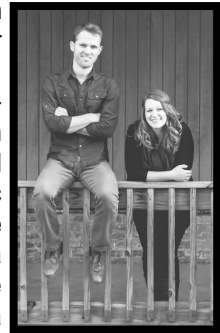

Youth Ministry

Youth are required to register their first day of camp. Packets are also available at local Missionary Churches. Registration fees cover meals, lodging, program, recreation and insurance. OUR "LIFE TOGETHER" AGREEMENT

*Working to Create an Atmosphere of
Loving Kindness and Respect*

1. Christ-like attitudes and modesty are expected in our dress, behavior and entertainment choices.
2. Our speed limit is **5 MPH** at all times for the safety of our children. Please observe carefully.
3. NO tobacco, alcohol, e-cigarettes, marijuana, or any illegal drugs are allowed on the camp property.
4. Children are not to be left at the camp without a designated, responsible adult on the grounds. The camp will not be held responsible for the care of the children except during children's activities (see children's registration packet).
5. Children under the age of 12 must be on their campsite after 10:00 PM unless accompanied by an adult.
6. The playground is closed from 10:00 PM until 8:00 AM. It will be closed during evening services. Children not attending the evening services must remain under adult supervision.
7. All single youth who have completed 6th – 12th grades **MUST REGISTER** regardless of their length of stay. Post high school students are welcome to attend youth services, but are not allowed in the youth area at other times. Only registered youth campers may participate in youth camp activities and meals, including evening activities.
8. To protect this beautiful camp that God has given us, the removal or cutting of any trees or moving of any lot markers must have prior Board approval. All used water must be disposed of through the septic system. NO water from dishes, bathing, etc. may be drained onto the ground.
9. Unmarried individuals under 21 years of age may not occupy a camp site unless accompanied by an adult (age 21 or older) claiming responsibility for them.
10. Please be respectful of others' quiet time between the hours of 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
